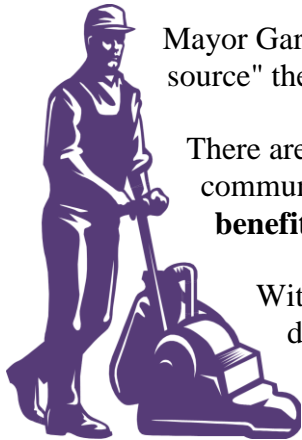


On May 5...
